NOTICE
OIL AND GAS BOARD

Pursuant to the authority of T.C.A. 60-1-202 and the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Board found in section 1040-6-1-.01(1) of the official rules and regulations of the State of Tennessee, a board meeting is set for **October 27 and 28, 2008 at 9:00 am ET at the Knoxville Field, 3711 Middlebrook Pike, Knoxville Tennessee.**

- 1) This meeting is to consider the request for the contested case of Deloy Miller C/O Miller Petroleum, Inc with the State of Tennessee Oil and Gas Board under the Water Pollution Control. This company is in violation of 1040-2-9-.04 "Time Limit for Plugging Wells". The total amount of the fine is \$193,000. There will be an Administrative Law Judge present to consider the proceedings.
- 2) This meeting is to consider the request for the contested cases of East Tennessee Consultants, East Tennessee Consultants II and Intrastate Energy Corporation with the State of Tennessee Oil and Gas Board under Water Pollution Control. These companies are in violation of 1040-2-9-.04 "Time Limit for Plugging Wells". The total amount of the fine for all three companies combined is \$109,000 for violation of the regulations. There will be an Administrative Law Judge present to consider the proceedings.
- 3) There will be a brief discussion, if time allows, for the current casing policies and the soon to be revised wellhead policies by the oil and gas board. This discussion will involve the current interpretation of the rules by the department.

All interested persons, including operators, producers, landowners, and royalty and mineral owners are hereby notified of said hearing and will be granted the opportunity in person or by attorney, including appropriate responsive pleadings, and to present evidence and argument on all issues involved pertaining to the foregoing items.
