NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Division of Water Pollution Control will hold a public hearing pursuant to Rule **1200-4-5-.06 (9)**.

**Place: Doyle Elementary School gymnasium**

**Date: Thursday, September 6, 2007**

**Time: 7:00 p.m.**

Public comments will be received concerning the proposed permit action described below:

Tennessee proposes to modify the existing NPDES permit (**TN0077691**) to authorize the City of Spencer to discharge treated municipal wastewater to an infiltration basin and constructed wetlands with discharge to Mile 104.6 of the Caney Fork River only in the event the infiltration basin/constructed wetland system is receiving maintenance or flooded. Additionally, the division proposes to reissue the existing NPDES permit (**TN0077704**) to the City of Spencer to authorize discharge of treated municipal wastewater to the headwaters of Lick Branch on a temporary basis.

The hearing officer may limit the length of oral presentation in order to allow parties an opportunity to speak, and will require that all testimony be relevant to water quality issues. Written testimony will be accepted at the hearing, for ten (10) working days following the hearing, and will be considered part of the hearing record.

Interested persons may obtain additional information, a copy of the draft permit, the rationale and inspect and copy forms and related documents at the Division's Central Office at the address listed above. **You may make an appointment with Ms. Sharon A. Baggett to view the permit by calling (615) 532-1172.**

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate in these proceedings (or review the administrative file record) should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten working days prior to **September 6 2007**, to allow time to provide such aid or services.
